Level 1 District-Sponsored Licensing OR Experienced-Based Guided Coaching

Quarterly check-ins (virtual or on-site) that provide:

- Goal setting
- Review of DPI portfolio rubric
- Review of progress
 - Portfolio or point system
- Feedback and coaching
- On-going support via phone calls and emails
- Triangle of collaboration with district

Level 2A In-District Coaching for Cohorts of Licensees (Minimum of 3 days)

Up to five new district teachers and/or up to three substitute teachers per district cohort

- One-day initial training for licensees and/or substitutes
- Virtual or on-site meeting with participating district-level personnel to understand current initiatives and needs for licensees and/or substitute teachers
- Monthly communication with support and resources for licensees and/or substitutes
- Assistance via email and phone calls

Level 2B Customized In-District Service

- Customized licensee (either district-sponsored or experience-based) training to meet district needs and fulfill PI-34 requirements
- Licensee or substitute professional learning opportunities
- Portfolio or point system requirements
- In-district observation and feedback

Level 2C Technical Assistance

- One-time coaching/feedback session
- Review of portfolio prior to submission
- On-going technical support via emails and phone calls
