Level 2 Customized Service

Working in collaboration with school-based staff, the School Counselor will provide customized support including but not limited to:

- Consult with school personnel, parents, and community resource staff to assess needs of individual students, families, and the school community
- Provide universal SEL programming using district resources to address the Wisconsin Social and Emotional Learning Competencies and the ASCA Mindsets and Behaviors for Student Success
- Provide targeted or intensive social, emotional, or behavioral interventions and related progress monitoring
- Provide other system-support services to address unique gaps and needs in the school system
- Deliver indirect services to build capacity in school staff in social, emotional, academic, and career development for all students
- Provide state-required field supervision for school counseling practicum students
