- Invoices will be sent to districts prior to June 1st
- Certificate will be sent after district payment is received. (*Please indicate below who the license should be sent to)
- Covers school 24/7 before, during or after school
- Covers entire facility, regardless of whether person(s) showing movie are affiliated with school
- Movie may be obtained from any legal source (rental store, home collection, etc.)
- Cost is based on total student enrollment at each school building that you want covered.
