

The CESA 4 Multilingual Learner program works collaboratively to build programming and provide services to schools in support of efforts related to Title III, English learners, and bilingual/bicultural programming. Specific assignments will include field-work assisting districts with newcomers, developing programs aligned with WI EL Handbook and federal requirements, implementing Language Instruction Educational Programs, (LIEP) ACCESS testing, ELP screeners, and continuous improvement processes that advance English language learners in both content and English language development. Educators will receive direct coaching including, but not limited to: • Planning for language and content integration based on the WIDA ELD 2020 standards framework Providing culturally relevant instruction • Integrating disciplinary literacy, language, and learning • Implementation of modifications and accommodations for ELs Districts can customize the sessions, goals, and coaching methods for this service **Customized District Language and Culture Professional Development** Level 2C (Session = 1/2 day) This program offers staff training including, but not limited to WIDA ELD standards, SIOP strategies, Co-Teaching, Co-Planning, Co-Assessing, Understanding the Language of the Content Areas, Supporting Newcomers in the classroom, and Boosting Second Language Acquisition. Districts can customize the number of days, goals, and coaching methods for this service.
